





CREATE FY16 Annual Report

The CREATE (Colorado Resource for Emergency and Trauma Education) Fiscal Year 2016 concluded on June 30, 2016. CREATE assists public and private entities in improving and expanding the emergency medical and trauma system in Colorado. Over the course of the grant year, 985 students were trained through CREATE funding. Below are some overarching highlights from FY16:


FY 2016 At-A-Glance

- •985 students trained




Applicants requested \$593,687.16 in CREATE funds and the Expert Review Committee (ERC) approved \$543,190.61. The table on page two outlines where the funds were allocated by each Regional Emergency Medical and Trauma Advisory Council (RETAC).



Of the 78 approved applications, there were 164 courses funded outlined by training type in the diagram below. Overall, 249 EMTS providers were able to attend an emergency and/or trauma conference, there are 88 new Nationally Registered EMS providers, and 648 EMTS providers received continuing education.



The CREATE Expert Review Committee (ERC) met on a monthly basis to review a total of 91 applications:



CRHC CREATE staff continued outreach efforts throughout FY16 to raise awareness about the program and provide technical assistance to current and potential applicants.
