Colorado Area Health Education Center (COAHEC) Opioid Use Disorder Community Health Worker Training	A free, online, self-paced training for community health workers on the front lines of the opioid crisis. Gain knowledge in treatment, recovery, harm reduction and conducting outreach programs in their communities.
Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment Health Navigator Program	A comprehensive list of tools directed at health navigation programs and employers including various policy, and research resources.
Colorado Rural Health Center Community Health Worker and Patient Navigator Network Meeting Series	A network meeting series held virtually on a bi-monthly basis.
