Family Health West Recognized as Colorado Rural Health Center's Featured Member of the Month

Denver, Colo - Family Health West is a nonprofit 501(c)3 critical access hospital located in Fruita, Colorado. In the mid-1940s local farmers and ranchers traveled to Utah bringing back supplies and bricks to build the hospital. Today, Family Health West, a comprehensive healthcare provider with over 500 employees, is committed to ensuring patients receive the best in health services.

Family Health West provides services to the community and nearby Mesa county residents through their 16-bed hospital, surgery and emergency care, lab and imaging services, physical rehabilitation, 85-bed assisted living residence, 90-bed long-term care facility and respite, specialized Alzheimer's care, outpatient procedure center, coagulation clinic, wound care center and pediatric therapy center.

As a long standing member of Colorado Rural Health Center, Family Health West is very involved with several CRHC programs and services. The hospital is currently involved with the Small Hospital Improvement Program (SHIP) grant, the Colorado Resource for Emergency And Trauma Education (CREATE) program and several regional workshops and other educational opportunities.

In addition, Family Health West's chief financial officer, Jason McCormick, serves on CRHC's board of directors, providing recommendations and expertise on rural health issues.

Recently Family Health West opened a new radiology wing in the hospital to provide early detection and diagnosis of the most common diseases affecting women. This also includes the new 3-D mammography and some of the most advanced MRI and osteoporosis machines in the Grand Valley. According to a <u>news release</u> published last week, over 200 3-D mammograms have been performed in the last two months.

This news comes after another <u>announcement in early July</u> that the hospital plans to add more space to the emergency room and expand from 16 inpatient beds to 25. In 2013, Family Health West Hospital had over 24,000 hospital visitors.
