Overview

Colorado's 11 RETACs

Colorado has 11 emergency medical and trauma regions, each of which consists of 5 or more counties. County government from the representative counties appoint members and a RETAC coordinator for the purpose of providing recommendations concerning regional area emergency medical and trauma service plans for those counties or cities and counties.

Each RETAC must:

- provide a Biennial Plan that details the regional medical services plan;
- provide an annual financial report that details the expenditures of money received.
