1 in every 5 deaths in the United States was caused by heart disease in 2022 ([CDC](#)). Three key risk factors for cardiovascular disease (CVD) are high blood pressure, high cholesterol, and smoking habits. About half of the people in the United States have at least one of these risk factors.

With the Community Analytics Platform (CAP), the Cardiovascular Screenings & Diagnoses Report allows you to filter for your patient population's CVD Risk Factors, Preventative Screenings or Participation in Prevention Programs, CVD Outcomes, CVD Interventions, and CVD Related Death. This report also includes socio-demographic and Admission, Discharge, and Transfer information, which can be helpful with understanding and serving this population.
