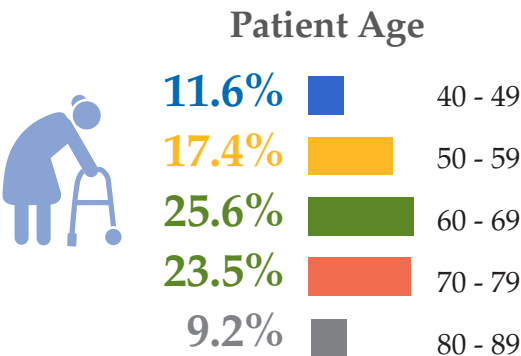
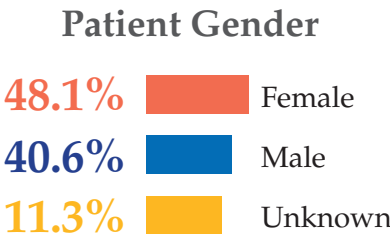
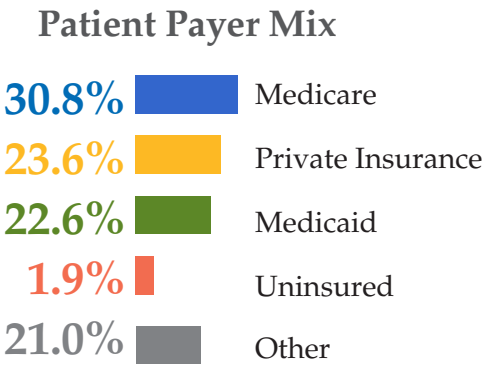
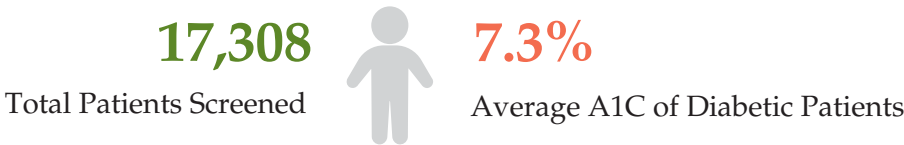


Diabetes Screening and Diagnosis
