

Obstetric Desert Report

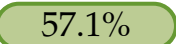
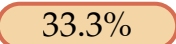
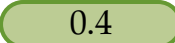
Launched in 2024, the Obstetric (OB) Desert Report provides four interactive dashboards - Overview, KPI Measures, Demographics, and Patient List - to help users better understand maternal health trends and outcomes. The dashboards enable users to view member births from 2020 through the most recent available month in the current year, monitor prenatal and postpartum visit rates, and compare key performance indicators (KPIs) with statewide Colorado benchmarks. This dashboard serves as a valuable tool for Regional Accountable Entity (RAE) reporting and supports data-driven efforts to improve maternal health access and outcomes.

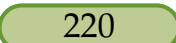
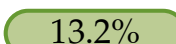
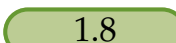

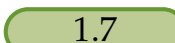
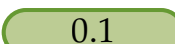

Prenatal Visits

- % of Deliveries w/ Prenatal Visits:  57.1%  33.3%
- Avg Total Visits:  8.0  5.8
- Avg Local Visits:  7.3  0.0
- Avg Out of County Visits:  0.4  1.5

Users can also view the number of qualifying deliveries, number of deliveries with prenatal visits, and CO PRAMS metrics.

Postpartum Visits

- Qualifying Deliveries:  220  35
- % w/ Postpartum Visits:  13.2%  2.9%
- Avg Total Visits:  1.8  1.0
- Avg Local Visits:  1.7  0.0
- Avg Out of County Visits:  0.1  1.0
