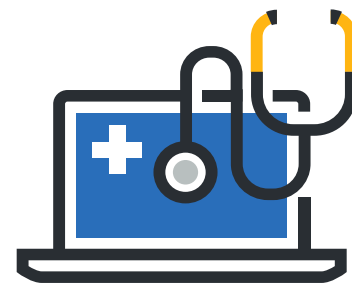
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Rural Connectivity Program

CRHC's Rural Connectivity Program is a program funded by the Office of eHealth Innovation, Department of Health Care Policy and Financing and in partnership with Carina Health Network (formerly CCMCN), and Contexture. The goals are to establish a sustainable model for rural connectivity, including connecting providers to Colorado's Health Information Exchanges (HIE) and supporting rural America's underserved rural population with analytics and data.



Two Powerful Data Platforms

There are two platforms that Carina Health Network makes available for RCP participants: the *Community Analytics Platform* and *Innovaccer Platform*. The **Community Analytics Platform (CAP)** provides a comprehensive suite of analytics to allow rural health providers to view population health metrics, costs of care, and operational opportunities.

By accessing the analytics provided through the Community Analytics and Innovaccer platforms, CRHC assists providers with initiatives that address developing programs, understanding costs, refining workflows, and population health strategies, and more.

Incentivized, Sustainable Participation

Each August, eligible facilities that are participating in the Rural Connectivity Program receive sustainability payments. To qualify for payments, eligible facilities must be connected to one of the state's Health Information Exchanges (HIE), the Community Analytics Platform (CAP), and be fully participating in the Rural Connectivity Program.
